Volunteer with the PTA

The PTA is always looking for volunteers to help us help our children be successful! There are many ways you can help out, many of them only requiring a few hours of your time. Some of the more urgently needed volunteer opportunities include:

- ❑ **Fundraisers:** Help needed with distribution of fundraiser orders. Typically requires a couple of hours after 3:30 in the school cafeteria 1-3 days per school year.
- ❑ **Career Day:** The PTA desperately needs volunteers to help with Career Day! Time commitment is a few hours a month for planning, and then we also need some help the day of the event.
- ❑ Other opportunities include: Read-a-Thon, Variety Show, Ice Cream Social, Book Fair, Back to School Luncheon/BBQ, Class Directory Proofreading, Camp Fair, Holiday Shoppe, and more.

Much of the PTA membership fees are paid to the national PTA, so the funding for these enrichment experiences comes almost exclusively from the fundraising events the PTA sponsors every year. This is why your participation in these events is so important!

What has the PTA done lately?

Did your child participate in an Author Visit last year? Or get to work with the amazing Mexican Artist who visited the school? Did they see the Flamenco dancing presentations or participate in the traveling museum visits from Boston Museum of Science? I bet you didn't know that these are all events organized and funded by the PTA! It's true, your PTA is hard at work every year to add extra experiences to the student's school year. Things that stand out in the kids memories, reinforce their classroom learning, and enrich their learning environment.

Here are a few of the activities organized by the PTA every year:

- Throwback Prom
- Walk-a-Thon
- Annual Read-a-Thon for grades Pre-K through 8
- Career Day for grades 6-8
- Nutmeg Book Program and book purchases for Library Media Center
- Book Club (run by Heather Warner)
- Spelling Team activities
- Annual Run to Read 5k Road Race to raise funds for new library books.
- World Language area events such as the field trips for 7th & 8th grade to LaBrioche Bakery, Flamenco dancing presentations, and the annual Margarita's field trip for 7th grade Spanish students; chinchilla visit (from the Lutz Museum) for South American studies, French Intern visit from Yale for French students in all applicable grades, Mexican Artist visit for all Spanish students in all grades
- Traveling Programs from The Boston Museum of Science (2nd and 3rd grades)
- Author visits (typically two per year - one for grades K-4 and one for grades 5-8)
